ARUSHA



WATER

With an official height of 4562.13 meters (sometimes given as 4630 or 4566 meters), Mount Meru is the third highest mountain in Tanzania, making it one of the highest mountains in Africa. The mountain is located about 65 kilometers in a southwestern direction from Kilimanjaro. It is surrounded by the Arusha National Park. South of the mountain is the city of Arusha. Mount Meru, like the Kilimanjaro massif, was formed by volcanic activity along the East African Rift Valley.

SHORTAGE OF WATER

Since 2010, all water points have been recorded and their condition documented with German assistance. A preliminary evaluation showed that of 74,331 water projects, only 40,444 are functioning. In the current fiscal year, 5,386 projects are to be repaired. A statistician from the Ministry of Water cited as important causes for the widespread non-functioning of water projects:

- Installation work is carried out sloppily
- Responsible persons neglect maintenance / incompetent maintenance
- Incompetent supervisors at all levels
- Small damages cause a whole plant to fail
- Power outages cripple pumps; voltage fluctuations damage pumps
- Parts of the installation are stolen
- Sewage pipes are stolen and sold as scrap metal
- Consumers do not pay contributions
- Paid contributions are misappropriated or embezzled
- Illegal connections and manipulated water meters steal water without payment
- Water is supplied in exchange for bribes
- Vandalism damages the facilities / consumers do not feel responsible for the facilities
- Agricultural activities and climate change endanger groundwater
- Forests are cleared in water protection areas



CHALLENGES



THEFT AND CORRUPTION

People do not believe the government. Funds have been embezzled. That is why most people steal water from the pipes, because otherwise it would never arrive, because industries receive this water.

- Cement block factory operated with illegally tapped water for 10 years
- Chadema MPs said in parliament that 80% of wells funded by the World Bank from 2007 to 2010 did not produce water.
- In Dar-Res-Salaam, 57.4% of tap water is lost to leaks (about 22%) and theft (about 35%).



MOUNTAIN ERUPTION

Due to eruption, the springs are blocked or closed and no more water flows. Another reason are the dry seasons, which are getting longer.

CHALLENGES



SHORTAGE OF WATER

A survey by a Dutch aid organization found that 70% of schools do not have adequate sanitary facilities. This has a negative impact on school attendance and performance, especially for girls.

A specialized Dutch company is cooperating with firms in Arusha to upgrade the overburdened sanitation system. Currently, only 15% of the more than 500,000 inhabitants are connected to the sewage network, which is only 44 km long and has about 4000 connections.

SOLUTION



GIVE COMMUNITY COMPETENCIES

Communities consist of a certain number of farm families that have joined together. It is a closed ecosystem. This system supports each other and creates opportunities together. One of these communities planted and managed coffee plantations. They have joined together as a corporate and act together in economic transactions. This community shares the products among themselves. In this way, they ensure each other's income.

- This in turn has an impact on institutions such as schools and social centers, as well as kindergartens. In the end, they create a healthy and positive environment for their children.
- They can go to school and receive food and drink. If we now give the communities access to become independent of the water supply,
- their health status will also improve.
- What is equally important for the people down there is the independence of water supplies, for the coffee plantations.
- They can plant permanently, plant more, and have again thereby more yield. The water is also not contaminated and thus leads to better and healthier plants, which will then in turn bear healthy fruit / coffee beans.

SCHOOLS

The Ministry has not yet issued a formal ban on corporal punishment. The Education (Corporal Punishment) Regulations of 1979 continue to be valid law, according to which only the principal or teachers authorized by him in writing to do so may administer up to 4 strokes, which are theoretically to be recorded in a punishment register.



The 25 universities and 15 colleges produce about 10,000 graduates with academic degrees each year. Since there are almost no corresponding jobs (only math teachers, engineers and skilled workers are in demand), students must prepare themselves to work independently or to acquire the skills that are actually in demand in the economy. An academic title alone is virtually worthless.

OFFER PROSPECTS & OPPORTUNITIES

- Children need early access to practical knowledge that will prepare them for life after school. Engineers are needed, and skilled workers are needed.
- Combining this with agribusiness and a suitable profession would fill several gaps.
- This requires schools that teach without violence, as well as partnerships in other German countries to learn these skills.



These schools must be implemented in the communities, so that the children do not have to walk 5 km to school. The subjects could then also find direct application on the plantations and at the waterworks.

VISION PEOPLE

We need volunteers, as well as money



ORPHANAGE

They urgently need physical support as well as money for, powdered milk, gas, food, clothing and salary.

This project can already be implemented directly. All contacts are available, as well as possibilities of accommodation. A voluntary social year or from 3 months stay, are feasible.

STRENGTHEN SOCIETY & AWARENESS

The organization Women in Law and Development in Africa (www.wildaftanzania.org) called on the government to modernize the outdated Marriage Act of 1971. It allows girls to marry with parental consent from the age of 14. By the age of 18, 40% of Tanzanian girls are married. This is often economically motivated, leading to high birth rates and endangering the health and lives of young mothers and children. Those who give birth too early are also at high risk of developing fistula. Every year, about 8,000 girls drop out of school because of pregnancy.

The reason for this is:

- illegitimate
- lack of money
- Rape

When children are born, many of the children are born in the jungle and left there for the animals. Still others are placed in boxes in front of a hospital and then given to the orphanage.

WHAT THEY NEED IS

They rely on outside help:

- They need regular gas for cooking,
- powdered milk for the babies,
- food and
- clothes, as well as
- #physical support from educators.

MR. GIDION

HEAD OF MARKETING & SALES DEP.

Mr. Gidion, 63, is a farmer and in the collective enterprise of the Farmer Head of Marketing Chef. He is also the knowledge bearer on organic coffee cultivation. The government calls him as a consultant for this cultivation method and has chosen him to pass on the knowledge to as many farmers as possible.

He was allergic as a youth to the use of chemicals/fertilizers used on the plantations. These means were used for no real reason. He developed a rash and asthma. After he took over the plantation in 2007, he uprooted all the trees, let the soil rest and planted completely new plants and used nature to control pests. Today the cooperation has 4500 trees and the organic certificate. The diseases are gone.



FENCE

SECURITY

Mr. Gidion lives on a self-sufficient farm. He produces biogas and uses 90% of the food from the garden. He has cows, pigs, chickens, dogs and cats.

Mr. Gidion is receiving increased attention. His plantation is entered more often by unauthorized people. Furthermore, animals hurt the plants and thus damage the growing process.

Mr. Gidion needs a fence to protect himself, his plantation and his animals on the farm.

PROJECT DEPENDENCIES

There are thousands of such communities in Tanzania.

If we help with the water and fences, the whole ecological and economic relationship will change positively. This shows the parents that it is worth learning more about it. The children get the opportunity of the prospect of a future job. Food and water is already today, like yesterday's gold.

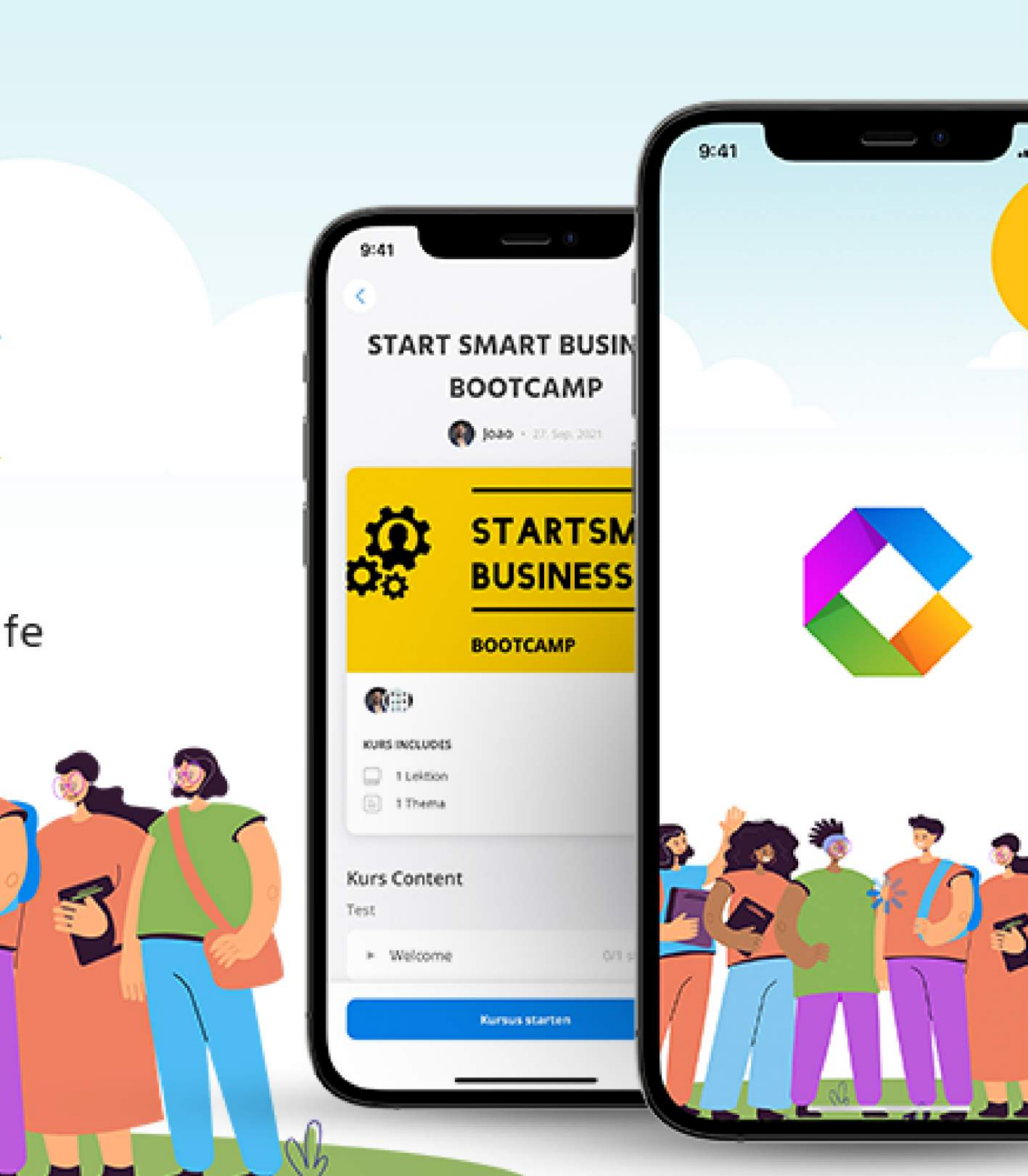

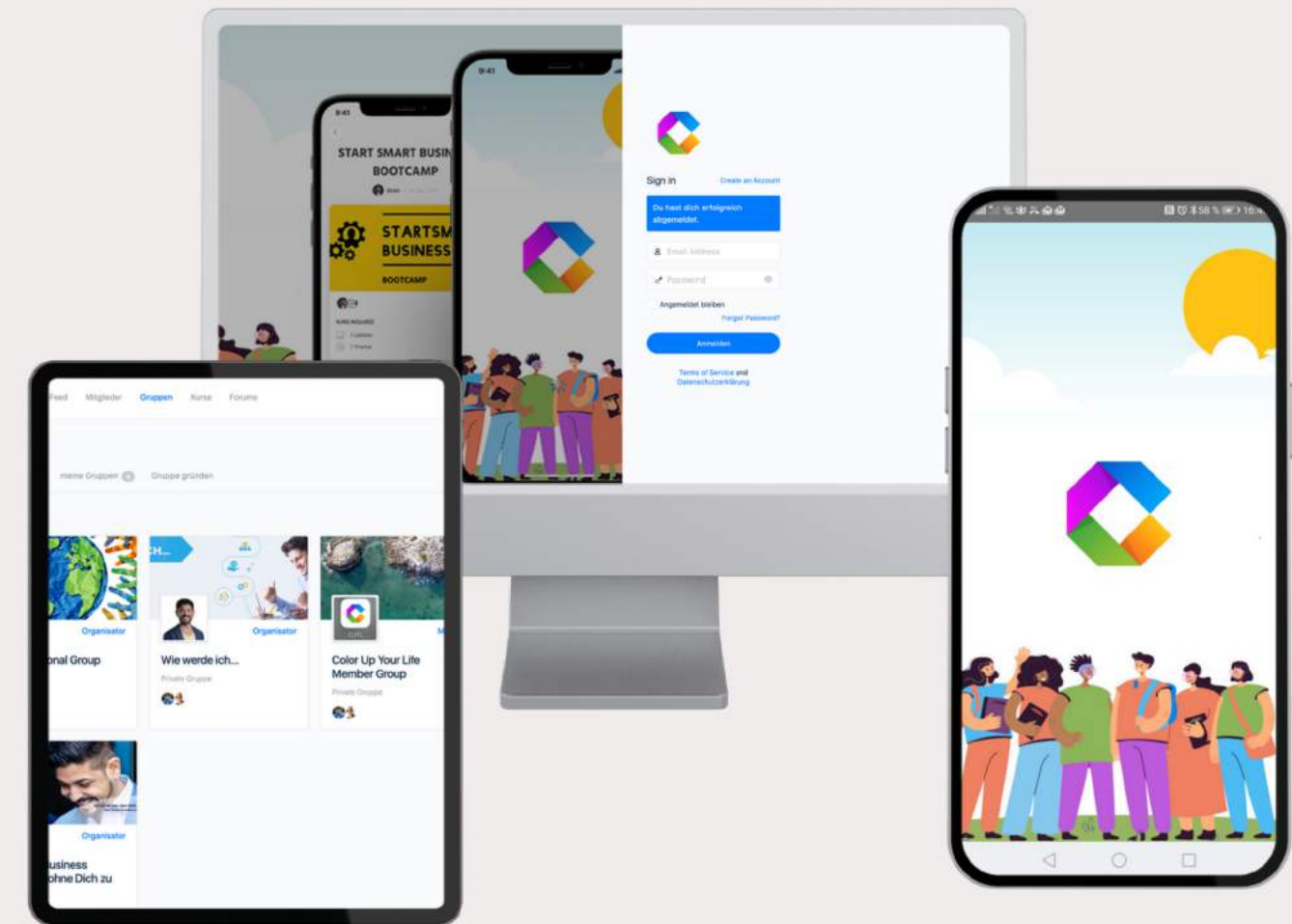
